

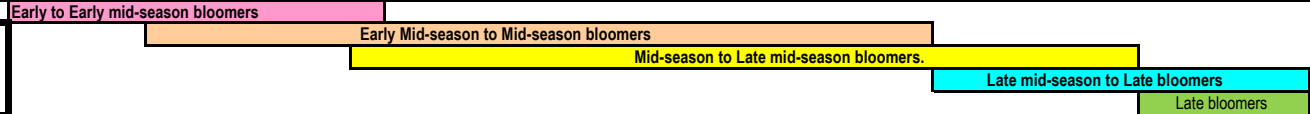


GRANDPA'S ORCHARD®

SWEET CHERRY POLLINATION GUIDE

NOTE: Bloom times can vary according to region and current year's weather and season. Varieties listed in general order of bloom ranges, and may bloom in somewhat different orders some years.

Tart cherry: All tart cherries are self-fertile, and do not require pollinators. Although tart cherries can cross-pollinate sweet cherry, they should not be depended on because they bloom much later typically.

KEY TO SYMBOLS AND COLOR CODING.

- X** Not a genetically compatible pollinator for that variety. Use another variety for adequate pollination
- SF** Self-fertile variety. No other pollinator required. Self-fertile varieties make great pollinators for other varieties in similar bloom periods.
- No color in block. Suitable as a pollinator for that variety, if bloom coincides. Varieties are genetically pollen compatible.
- Not recommended as pollinator because bloom times do not overlap sufficiently, even though pollen may be compatible.
